Introduction

- 1. The Applicant is a staff member of the Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA). He is serving as an inventory and supply assistant at the GS-6/X level on a permanent contract. He filed the current Application on 26 February 2014 challenging the decision to abolish his post.
- 2. The Respondent submitted his Reply on 7 April 2014, in which he asserted, *inter alia*, that the Application was not receivable for the following reasons: (a) the Dispute Tribunal lacks authority to review the General Assembly's decision to abolish the Applicant's post; (b) the Applicant failed to file a request for management evaluation; and (c) identification of the Applicant's post for abolition does not constitute a final appealable administrative decision.
