

UNITED NATIONS DISPUTE TRIBUNAL

11. On 9 August 2018, the Ombudsman informed the Tribunal that parties are still actively involved in mediating this case and applied for more time within which to conclude the settlement discussions.

Directions and Orders

12. The Tribunal commends the parties for their sustained efforts at having this matter resolved without recourse to litigation.

13. The Tribunal **GRANTS** further suspension of proceedings.

14. Pursuant to art. 10.3 of the Statute of the Tribunal, and art. 19 of the Rules of Procedure, the matter of *Yabowork v Secretary-General of the United Nations* (Case No. UNDT/NBI/2016/071) is hereby further **SUSPENDED**

15. The parties are **DIRECTED** to jointly advise the Tribunal of the status of their consultations by **14 September 2018**

16. The Parties and/or OMS should advise the Tribunal on the status of mediation by **14 September 2018**
