

Background

1. On 23 February 2018, the Applicant filed an application contesting the Under-Secretary-
disciplinary sanction of dismissal from service for serious misconduct in accordance with staff rule 10.2(a)(ix).
2. The Respondent filed a reply on 28 March 2018 and an amended reply on 24
3. The Tribunal considers that the matter should proceed to a case management discussion (CMD) to:
 - a. Discuss the claims and issues in the case;
 - b. Identify the factual and legal issues to be determined;
 - c. Consider what further information, if any, is required;
 - d. Identify any documents to be disclosed;
 - e. Consider if the case may be decided on the basis of the documents, or whether a hearing should be held, and, if there is to be a hearing, to set the dates, identify the witnesses to be called and the documents to be presented; and
 - f. Discuss any other matter relevant to these proceedings.
