Introduction and Procedural History

1. At the time of the impugned decision, the Applicant served as a Security Coordination Officer at the United Nations Mission in Iraq (UNAMI). He held a fixed term appointment at the P-4 level and was based in Kirkuk.

2. On 14 December 2018, the Applicant to separate him from service with compensation *in lieu* of notice without termination indemnity in accordance with staff rule 10.2(a)(viii).
