Introduction

1. The Applicantis a Movement Control Assistant at the -5Sevel working with the United Nations Support Office in Somalia ("UNSOS").

- 2. On 17 November 2020, the Applicant filed before the United Nations Dispute Tribunal in Nairobi an application for suspension, pending manageevaluation, of a decision by UNSOS to deduct from his salary a sum 655,032.33. This case was registered as Case NdNDT/NBI/2020/092
- 3. On 19 November 2020, the Tribunal issued Order No. 228 (NBI/2020) and dismissed the pplication on the ground that the contested decision was not unlawful.
- 4. On the same day, 19 November 2020, the Applicant once more filed the same application as the one he had filed on November 2020, seeking suspension, pending management evaluation, of a decision by UNSOS that from his salary a sum of USD5,032.33.
- 5. Article 13 of the UNDT Rules of Procedure requires only that the Tribunal transmit a copy of the suspension of action ("SOA") application to the Respondent and to issue a decision within five days thereof. Sithwere is no requirement under art. 2.2 of the UNDT Statute or art. 13 of the Rules of Procedure, for the Tribunal to await the Respondent's response before the Applicant's request is considered, the Tribunal decided to adjudicate the current SOA application to the Respondent and to issue a decision within five days thereof. Sithwere is no requirement under art. 2.2

Considerations

6. The Tribunal notes thathe facts andremedies sought in this application are similar to those of the application in Case No.UNDT/NBI/2020/092 which the
