



**1 The Applicant is a former P-3 Disarmament, Demobilization and Reintegration (“DDR”) Officer with the United Nations Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo based in Goma<sup>1</sup> On 14 October 2021, she filed an application before the Dispute Tribunal contesting the decision to not renew her fixed term appointment (“FTA”) beyond 30 June 2021 and to separate her on retirement<sup>2</sup>**

**2 The Respondent filed a reply on 17 November 2021 in which it is argued that the contested decision was lawful.<sup>3</sup>**

**3 In view of the submissions by the parties, the Tribunal has decided to hold a case management discussion (“CMD”). The purpose of the CMD is to**
