Introduction

- 1. By Order No. 156 (NY/2013), the Dispute Turitial directed the parties to file a joint submission stating pter alia, whether they agree to attempt to resolve Cases No. UNDT/NY/2012/003 and NDT/NY/2013/033 informally either through the Mediation Division or through inter partes discussions. Failing to agree to informal resolution of the cases, the parties were directed to file a jointly-signed statement in preparation for a hearing on the merits. The parties were ordered to file their joint statement by 5 p.m. on July 2013. The deadline was subsequently extended by Order No. 162 (NY/2013), the Respondent's request, until 15 July 2013.
- 2. On 15 July 2013, the parties filed a joisubmission statig their agreement to attempt informal resolution of the casthrough the Mediation Division of the United Nations Office of the Ombudsmand Mediation Services. The parties request the Tribunal to "give appropriadirection to the Mediation Division for mediation proceedings to be initiated on example dited basis". The parties agree that mediation should proceed as soon as possible.

Consideration

3. The Tribunal finds it approparte to refer the cases the Mediation Division and to suspend the present proceedings for two weeks to facilitate informal resolution of the cases. The relatively showertion of time of two weeks is given in view of the urgency with which the pieces are seeking informal resolution. In the Tribunal's view, this case is particularly ripe for informal resolution, and the Tribunal appreciates that the Meiotiat Division and the parties will take all appropriate steps to ensure that the seescare resolved in most expeditious manner possible.
