6. The Respondent's motion for summary judgment is therefore to be rejected.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

7. By **4:00 p.m. on Monday, 26 July 2021**, the Applicant is to file his final submissions on whether Abd Al-Shakour et al. 2021-UNAT-1107 is dispositive for the determination of the present cases. The pleading is to be a maximum of five pages, using the font Times New Roman, size 12 and 1.5 line spacing;

8. By **4:00 p.m. on Monday, 2 August 2021**, the Respondent to file his response to the Applicant's 26 July 2021 submissions. The pleading is to be a maximum of five pages, using the font Times New Roman, size 12 and 1.5 line spacing;

9. By **4:00 p.m. on Friday, 6 August 2021**, the Applicant is to file his final observations to the Respondent's 2 August 2021 response. The pleading is to be a maximum of two pages, using the font Times New Roman, size 12 and 1.5 line spacing;

10. Unless otherwise ordered, on receipt of the latest of the aforementioned statements or at the expiration of the provided time limit, the Tribunal will adjudicate on the matter and deliver Judgment based on the documents on record.
