Introduction

1. On 11 July 2024, a hearing was held at which the Applicant and AA gave testimony. Subsequent to the hearing, the Tribunal instructed the parties that it would order them to file written closing statements by a written order.

2. In light of the above,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. By **4:00 p.m. on Thursday, 8 August 2024**, the Applicant is to file his closing statement, which is to be seven pages maximum, using Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing. The closing statement is solely to be based on previously filed pleadings and evidence, and no new pleadings or evidence are allowed at this stage;

2. By **4:00 p.m. on Thursday, 22 August 2024**, the Respondent is to file his length of seven pages, using Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing. The closing statement is solely to be based on previously filed pleadings and evidence, and no new pleadings or evidence are allowed at this stage;

3. By **4:00 p.m. on Thursday, 29 August 2024**, the Applicant may file a statement of any final observ

This statement of final observations by the Applicant must be a maximum of two pages, using Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing. It must be solely based on previously filed pleadings and evidence, and no new pleadings or evidence are allowed at this stage.
