POSITION OF THE GROUP OF 77 AND CHINA ON THE POSSIBILITY OF HOLDING A HIGH-LEVEL EVENT ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT*

1. The Ministers for Foreign Affairs of the Members States of the Group of 77 and China, in the Declaration issued on the occasion of their Thirty-Second Annual Meeting, held in New York on 26 September 2008, "welcomed the offer made by the Government of Brazil to host in 2012 a World Summit on Sustainable Development to review the 20-year progress achieved in the implementation of the outcomes of the United Nations Conference on Environment and Sustainable Development, held in Rio de Janeiro, on 3-14 June 1992, including the Wo -1. gsgon Sus-on J0.0001 T3 0.3599 Tw 17.2694

- e) A 2012 conference would secure renewed political commitment and support for sustainable development;
- f) A 2012 conference would reiterate the centrality of the Rio Declaration on Development and Environment, in particular the principle of common but differentiated responsibilities;
- g) A preparatory process, including modalities for negotiations, should be decided upon by the General Assembly at its 64th session, taking adequately into account the work of the Commission on Sustainable Development with a view to avoiding duplication of work;
- 4. In conclusion, the Group of 77 and China reiterates its support to the offer of the Government of Brazil to host the UN Conference on Sustainable Development in 2012.
