The Permanent Mission of Argentina to the United Nations presents its compliments to the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs, Division for Sustainable Development, and refers to Resolution 63/212 of the General Assembly on Implementation of Agenda 21, the Programme of Further Implementation of Agenda 21, and the outcomes of the World Summit on Sustainable Development.
