Furthermore, efforts are made to incorporate social, ethical and environment aspects into different national strategies and programmes. Thus. for example, in 2008 the Council of Ministers adopted "The newparoach to public procurement.uling" Procurement and Small and Medium-sized Enterprises, Innovation and Sustainabevelompment". Sustainability aspects have also reflected been in the "Natioha Reform Programme for 2007-2011 to implement the Lisbon Strategy".
