Today, we face **great challenges**:

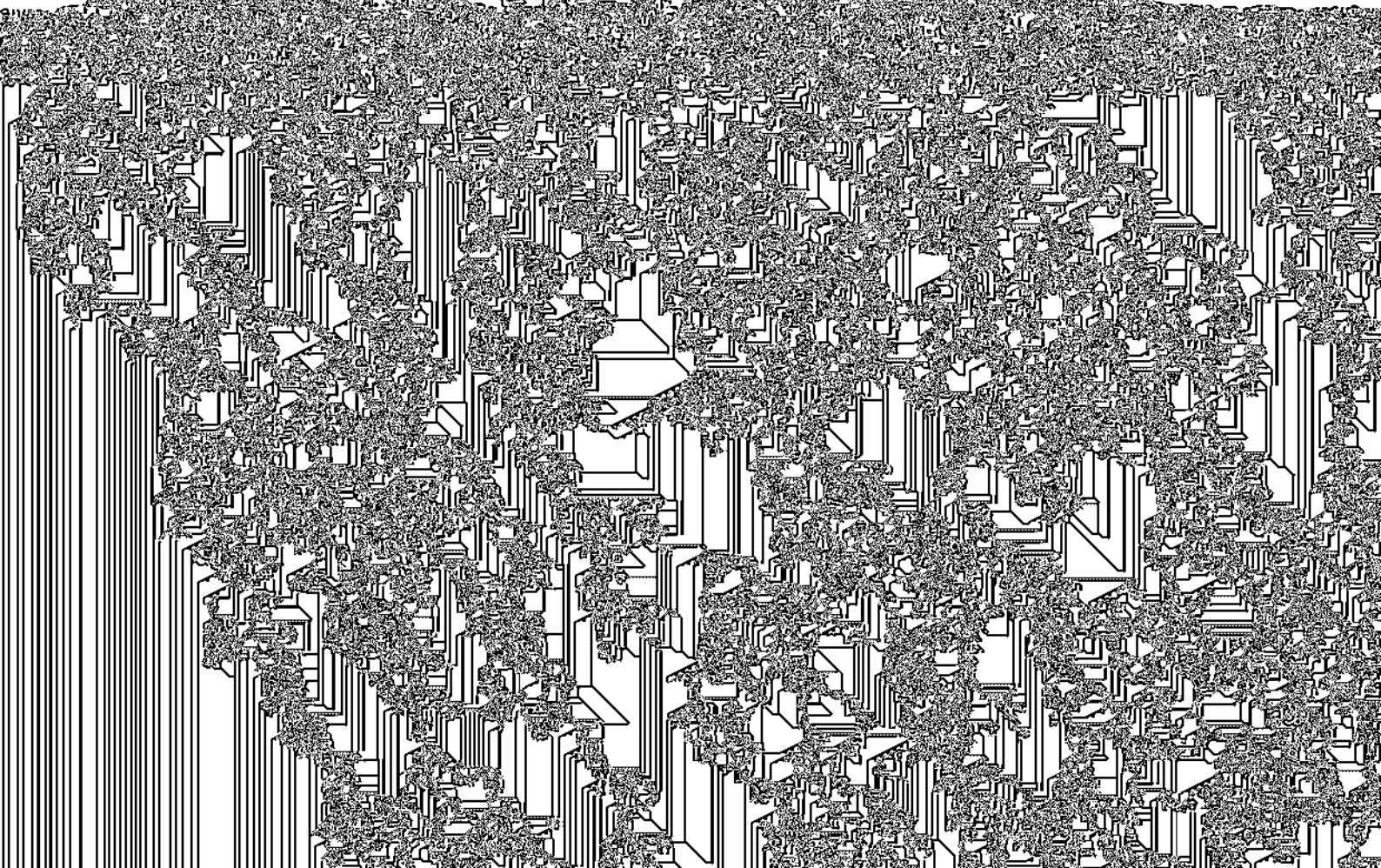
- achieving a world without poverty and hunger by 2030;
