### **ACTIVITIES FUNDED:**

- (a) General Temporary Assistance salary for one staff member to coordinate the work of the Financing for Development preparatory committee (TOR, para. (d)).
- (b) Salaries for consultants to provide services:
  - (i) to upgrade the electronic networking and data processing capabilities and to coordinate the production of a CD ROM accompanying a follow-up publication on the International Conference on Financing for Development (ICFFD), entitled "Building on Momentum" (Sales No.E.02.II.A.5) (see TOR, para.(d) & (i)).
  - (ii) to promote and mobilize countries with preparatory processes and its outcomes through an effective public outreach programme (see TOR, para. (d)) and to produce a follow-up document on the ICFFD (see TOR, para. (d) & (i)).
  - (iii) to provide substantive and political advice to the Executive Committee (see TOR, paras. (3), (5), (6))
  - (iv) to liaise with members of the group (see TOR, para.(b)).
- (c) Travel of staff to attend intergovernmental meetings, in particular regional preparatory meetings for the International Conference on Financing for Development (ICFFD), as well as planning missions to the conference site. Other missions included conferences of institutional and non-institutional stakeholders, including civil society and private sector organizations, which were of relevance to the Financing for Development process (see TOR, para. (b) & (d)).
- (d) Travel of representatives to attend high-level intergovernmental events in preparation of the ICFFD, in particular the Substantive Session of the Preparatory Committee. (see TOR, paras. (d)).
- (e) Contractual services to provide:
  - (i) the reproduction of 2000 CD ROMs accompanying publication on the ICFFD (see (i)) (see TOR, para. (d)).

- (ii) production (including typesetting and transcription services) of public information on the IGFED (see TOR, para (a)).
- (iv) the organization of a two-day workshop on Financing for Development aimed at civil society (see TOR, para (a)).
- (f) Travel of Experts to attend:
- (i) a two-day workshop on Financing for Development aimed at civil society (see TOR, para (d)&(a)).
  - (ii) a conference on regional challenges facing regional banks related to financing for development (see TOR, para (d)).
  - (iii) a side event during the IGFED organized by UNCTAD (see TOR, para (d)).
  - (iv) the fourth substantive session of the Preparatory Committee (see TOR, para (d)).

## OUTCOMES/IMPLEMENTATION

- (a) Effective cooperation was established between the IGFED and the preceding four substantive sessions of the Preparatory Committee as well as, as well as the special high-level meeting of the UNCCD in the run-up to the WOC (Report of the UNCCD in 1997, 1. A Sustainable Outcome (A/A/257/32), President's Summary (E/2002/62), ...).
- (b) The requested services were delivered:
- (i) The FFD website was updated to reflect the latest intergovernmental developments and a CD-ROM was produced on the occasion of the UN publication called "Building on Monterrey" (Sales No. E.02.II.A.4).
  - (ii) A book entitled "Building on Monterrey" was launched (Sales No. E.02.II.A.5).

  - (iv) Luncheons and seminars with key figures of the European institutions were held.
- (c) Through participation at meetings relevant to financing for Development, staff effectively raised awareness and promoted and mobilized support for the Financing for Development process.
- (d) Funding the travel of representatives from developing countries ensured a geographically balanced distribution among meeting participants at intergovernmental events throughout follow-ups to the IGFED.
- (e) The requested services were delivered:
