



Joint statement of the International Disability Alliance (IDA) and International Disability and Development Consortium (IDDC) delivered during the substantive informal session on "Domestic Public Finance" (November 11) of the Preparatory Process for the Third International Conference on Financing for Development.

- Social protection floors, as promoted by the ILO, are an essential mechanism for reducing poverty among enallyleand marginalized populations, such as persons with disabilities, and it is critical therefore that social protection is explicitly inclusive of and accessible for persons with disabilities and their families.
