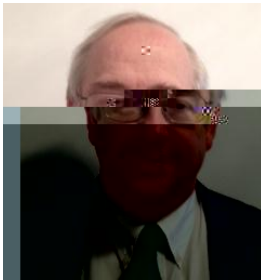
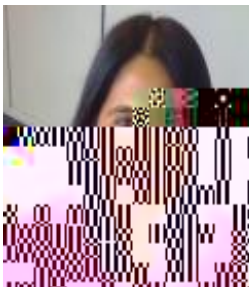

**Joseph L. Andrus** recently retired as the Head of the OECD Transfer Pricing Unit. In that position he led all of the transfer pricing work at the OECD including the transfer pricing work on the Base Erosion and Profit Shifting Product (BEPS). Prior to joining the OECD, Mr. Andrus was a transfer pricing partner at a major accounting firm and a major international law firm for more than 30 years, addressing transfer pricing disputes and planning issues in more than 20 countries. Previously he served as Deputy International Tax Counsel at the United States Treasury Department. Mr. Andrus is a graduate of the University of Chicago Law School.



**Nishana Gosai** is the Manager of the Transfer Pricing Unit of the South African Revenue Service.
