I n this regard, in June 2013, countries, the Collaborative Partnership on Forests, its member organizations, other relevant organizations, relevant regional and subregional forest-related mechanisms, institutions, instruments, organizations and processes, major groups and other stakeholders were invited to submit views and proposals on the IAF to the secretariat. In total, 46 responses were received which have been made available online, as individual responses, and as a compilation document. This compilation is included in the CD which has been distributed to all participants.
