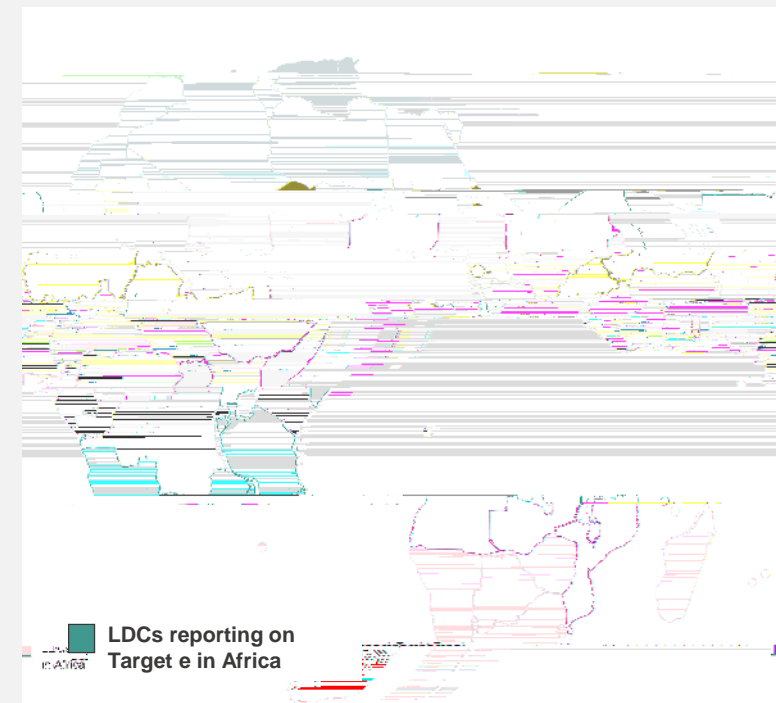

Support to LDCs to undertake actions to better **integrate climate change into DRR strategies**

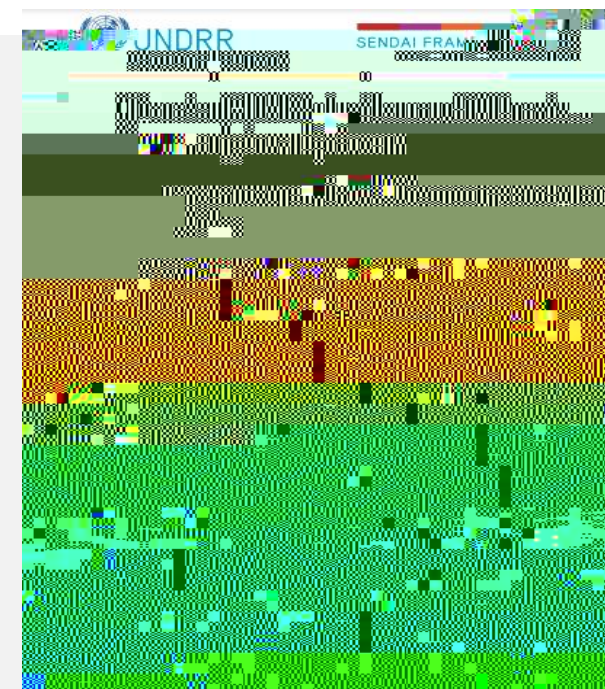

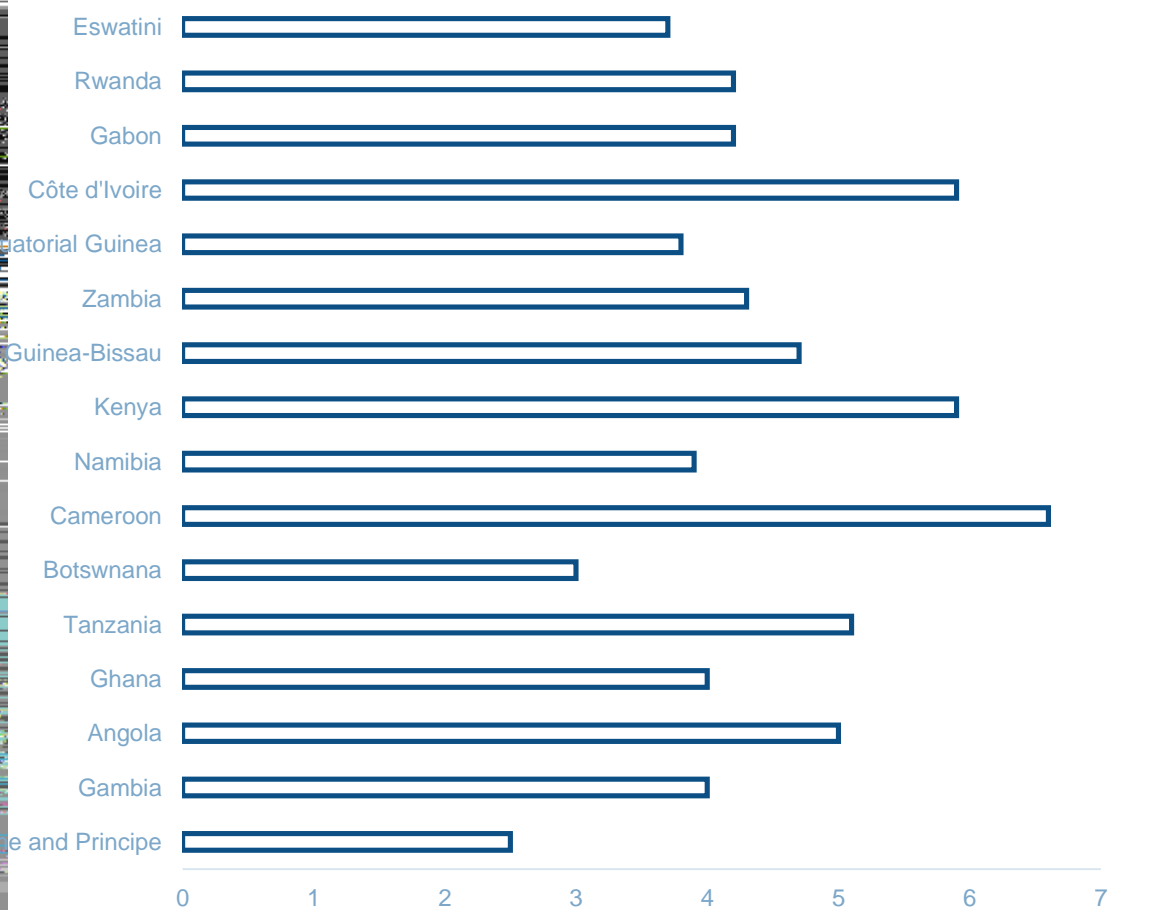
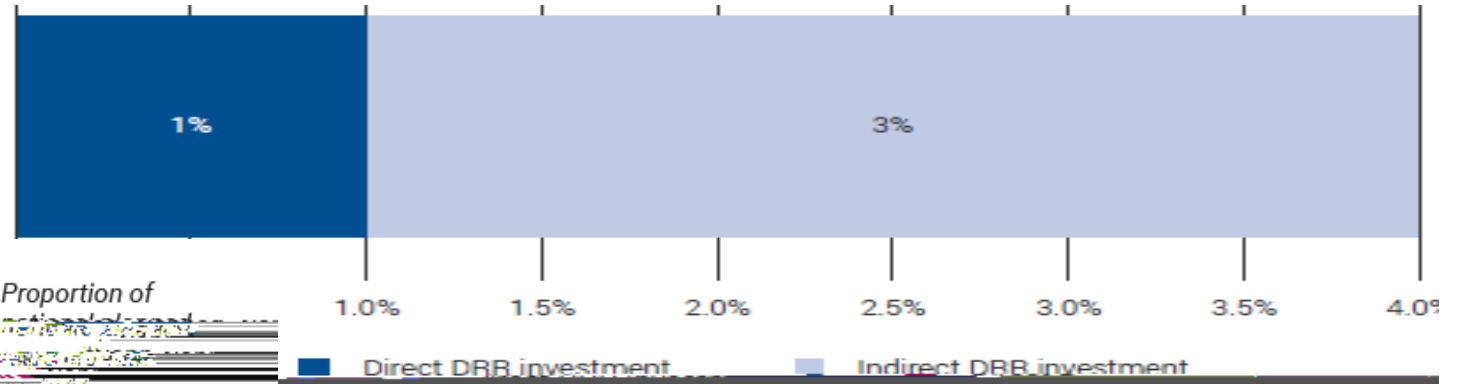


Applications of the risk profiles

Assess the result and compare allocated budget with risks



Key Challenges

Access to budget related data and political will

Difficult to track sectoral investment, (DRR investments cannot be counted separately from entire project or budget reports)

Collaboration across sectors

Finance and planning experts not familiar with DRR/CCA

Government budgets are developed and presented in different formats

Government ministries, departments and agencies do not normally prepare their budgets with all the classifications

Recommendations

Governments to promote a whole-of-society approach to ensure coherent development and implementation of adequately financed disaster risk reduction, and CCA strategies.

Strengthened dialogue among Ministries of Finance, Planning and DRR and CCA structures to mainstream **climate and disaster risk reduction finance**.

Current DRR, CCA and resilience planning processes such as NDC, NAPs, DRR strategies and national development plans are an opportunity to move towards
