
# Kisian-Busia Road and Kakira-Malaba Road

## Description and Rationale

The Kenyan segment (Kisian-Busia) is 104km long and is located in the Western part of Kenya. It terminates at Busia OSBP at the border of Uganda. The proposed upgrading will reduce vehicle operating costs and maintenance costs, and also reduce vehicular pollution due to the decrease in wait times and congestion. Further, expanding the highway will improve road safety features and reduce the number of accidents on the road.


The Ugandan segment (Kakira-Malaba) is 127 km long and is located at the Western part of Uganda, connecting Jinja with the Kenyan boarder at Malaba and is part of the main corridor. The interventions also include a 20 km road branch (Busitema – Busia) linking the Ugandan segment (Kakira-Malaba) to the Kenyan segment (Kisian-Busia).
