According to the [IMF April 2021 Fiscal Monitor](#), the COVID-19 Global Humanitarian Response Plan amounts to a staggering **\$12 TRILLION**.

According to the [OCHA funding tracker](#), the [COVID-19 Global Humanitarian Response Plan](#) for 2020 was funded at 40%, with **\$3.8 BILLION** out of **\$9.5 BILLION** requirements.

According to the UNSDG, UN teams repurposed around **\$3 BILLION** of existing funding, while additionally mobilizing nearly **\$2 BILLION** to support national and local efforts in the immediate response to the pandemic.
