Seventeenth Meeting of the Ad Hoc Working Group of the Whole on the Regular Process for Global Reporting and Assessment of the State of the Marine Environment, including Socioeconomic Aspects

The seventeenth meeting of the Ad Hoc Working Group of the Whole on the Regular Process for Global Reporting and Assessment of the State of the Marine Environment, including Socioeconomic Aspects (the “Regular Process”), will be held from 1 to 2 November 2022 at United Nations Headquarters. The meeting is convened in accordance with paragraph 317 of General Assembly resolution 76/72 of 9 December 2021 on “Oceans and the law of the sea”.

In that resolution, the General Assembly recalled that the Regular Process shall be overseen and guided by its Ad Hoc Working Group of the Whole, and decided that the Working Group shall facilitate the delivery of the outputs of the third cycle as outlined in the programme of work for the period 2021-2025 for the third cycle of the Regular Process.
