Eighteenth Meeting of the Ad Hoc Working Group of the Whole on the Regular Process for Global Reporting and Assessment of the State of the Marine Environment, including Socioeconomic Aspects

The eighteenth meeting of the Ad Hoc Working Group of the Whole on the Regular Process for Global Reporting and Assessment of the State of the Marine Environment, including Socioeconomic Aspects (the “Regular Process”), will be held from **27 to 28 March 2023 at United Nations Headquarters**. The meeting is convened in accordance with paragraph 352 of General Assembly resolution 77/248 of 30 December 2022 on “Oceans and the law of the sea”.

In that resolution, the General Assembly recalled that the Regular Process shall be overseen and guided by its Ad Hoc Working Group of the Whole, and decided that the Working Group shall facilitate the delivery of the outputs of the third cycle as outlined in the programme of work for the period 2021-2025 for the third cycle of the Regular Process.

The eighteenth meeting will consider, inter alia, the following documents prepared by the Group of Experts:

- The proposed scope of the next World Ocean Assessment(s);
- The comprehensive annotated outline of the World Ocean Assessment(s) containing a summary of content and format;
- The list of expertise needed for the writing teams;
- The assessment of potential gaps and overlaps in expertise and the way to manage them.
