1. The programme of work for the period 2021-2025 for the third cycle of the Regular Process for Global Reporting and Assessment of the State of the Marine Environment, including Socioeconomic Aspects (the "Regular Process"), endorsed by the United Nations General Assembly, includes in the activities for 2023 the holding of regional workshops on capacity-building aimed at strengthening the science-policy interface and in support of the next assessment(s) of the Regular Process.

II. Host, venue and date of the Workshops

- 2. The Government of Brazil offered to host a Workshop to support the development of the next United Nations Regular Process World Ocean Assessment on capacity building to strengthen the ocean science-policy interface, from 10 to 17 May 2023.
