The purpose of the country visits is to inform Member States to assess their overall national counter-terrorism efforts: their strengths. Weaknesses and technical assistance needs: good practices employed in the implementation of resolutions: and terrorism trends and challenges'

The visiting teams are led by CTED and include experts from a number of international, regional and sub-regional organizations, including ICAO'

The visits include consultations with the host Government and, where possible, on-site visits to relevant locations or facilities, such as airports and external border checkpoints'

The expert teams compile their observations into a report for the CTC: make recommendations for action: and identify Member States' technical assistance needs'

Resolution 3454 - and many subsequent Council resolutions on terrorism - address many issues of relevance to civil aviation'

- Resolution 306A calls upon all States to cooperate to strengthen the security of their international borders by combating fraudulent documents and advanced screening measures'
