



- The seizure of large amounts of weapons, including Kalashnikov machineguns, automatic and

semi-automatic guns, RPGs, mortar shells, gun silencers, detonators and hunting guns.

The attacks perpetrated on the 16<sup>th</sup> of May 2003 in Casablanca, against symbolic sites (Hotel "Farah", restaurant "Positano", "La casa de Espagna", the Jewish Alliance Circle, and the Jewish cemetery) were considered as a warning signal on the local and international extremist linkages, and the belligerent intentions of Al Qaida and its offshoots, namely the Salafist Group for Preaching and

deploy them in Morocco in order to carry out wide terrorist projects, in association with Al Qaida
