• At the regional level, Morocco has established humanitarian and development aid in Africa amongst its top diplomatic priorities. This is carried out through the implementation of strategic projects (Morocco-Gabon) but also through small but concrete and well-define cooperation projects, benefitting the poorest populations in essential sectors covering basic needs such as access to health, water, agriculture and fisheries, education and training, and electricity.

To conclude:

1. Morocco's contribution to the fight against terrorism reflects its firm belief that an offective international counterterrorism strategy must be implemented at three levels.

national, regional and international. The regional dimension is only meaningful if it is developed in a constructive spirit, with no exclusion or political tactics.

2. Morocco continues to support and contribute to the actions initiated by the CTC and its Executive Directorate, seeking to develop cooperation between African states and reinforce their capacities in the field of counterterrorism and the fight against violent extremism.
