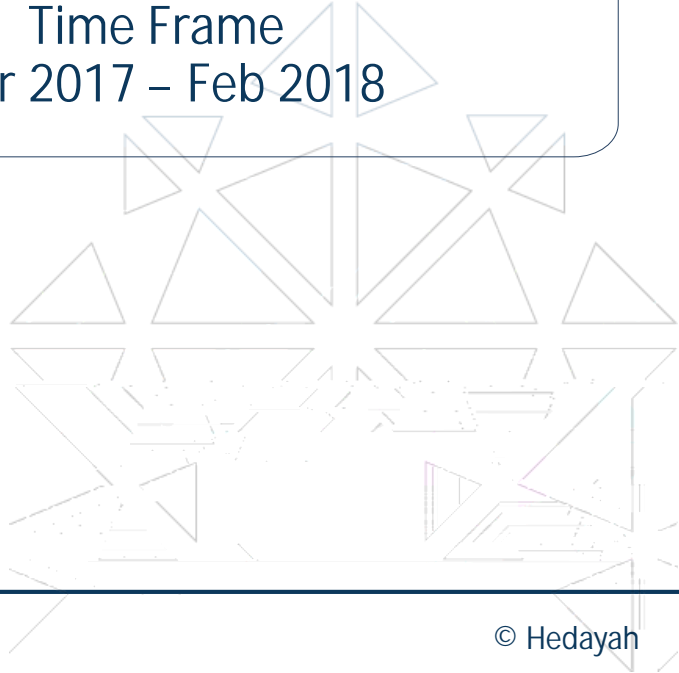
To promote social inclusion of vulnerable youth and prevent their radicalization through education, dialogue and civic engagement.
