Qi Dongyu, who took office on 1 August 2019 as Director General of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, has spent his life working on how to make sure the world is fed

Born in 1963 to a rice growing family in China's Hunan Province, Qi studied horticultural science at Hunan Agricultural University and then plant breeding and genetics at the Chinese Academy of Agricultural Sciences. He later added environmental science to his knowledge portfolio while earning a PhD at Wageningen University, in the Netherlands

He then progressed through a range of national and international activities, engaged simultaneously in science and management, all during a time when China's reform and opening up process led the country to dramatically reduce poverty and hunger in a country
