In-person experts from both organizations and other stakeholders from the region will consider the challenges that the current outlook presents to the delivery of the SDGs, in particular related to SDG 1, No Poverty, and offer suggestions for sound policies to ensure the well-being of people in Asia and the Pacific. A focus will be on highlighting solutions that will help developing countries in the region limit their risk to emerging vulnerabilities, including wage stagnation (BJ) (cuti h,
