## Statement by Mr. Boris N. Malakhov, Permanent Mission of the Russian Federation to the United Nations (25 April 2006)

Dear Mr. Chairman,

On behalf of the Russian delegation let me thank you for skilfully guiding the work of the Committee. I would also like to express my gratitude to Under-Secretary-General for Communications and Public Information Shashi Tharoor for the constructive and substantive statement at the first meeting containing strategy and main results of the work done by the Department of Public Information (DPI) in the area of information.
