RECOMMENDATIONS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF IN-MISSION 5-DAY QUARANTINE PERIOD FOR CONTINGENT 1



NB: Please note that for the <u>individual</u> uniformed personnel (IUP), apart from mandatory pre deployment testing, any other requirements (e.g. post -arrival in-mission quarantine) have been delegated to the mission leadership locally and such policy may therefore differ from mission to mission for IUPs.

MINIMUM ELEMENTS OF ROUTINE - BAY IN-MISSION QUARANTINE FOR CONTINGENTUNIFORMED PERSONNEL

As of April 1, 2022, upon arrival to the mission, contingent police/military uniformed personnel should quarantine for 5 days. At the end of the 5 day per iod, a COVID -19 antigen test may be conducted, and if negative, the personnel can be released from quarantine.

The following provides the minimum elements that must be implemented throughout th e routine 5-day quarantine period for contingent uniformed personnel . There should be strict adherence to the following guidance .

Note: Pre -deployement and p ost-deployment quarantine is no longer mandatory but optional for TCCs/PCCs.

These minimum elements to be implemented for this 5 -day in -mission guarantine period are:

• After arrival to the quarantine center , keep quarantined individual's movement outside the
