United Nations Medical Directors' Risk Mitigation Plan for COVID-19

All contacts who in the last 90 days have (i) completed their primary vaccination series, or (ii) have received a vaccine booster dose, or (iii) have reported a previous COVID-19 infection do not need to quarantine. In certain situations (for example there is a new variant of concern (VOC), or when indicated by national health authorities) all contacts should quarantine for 14 days as a precautionary measure, although this period could be shortened with testing, if the characteristics of the new variant and detection methods for it
