- Women represent the 46.23% of workers in the economic sector. - Cuba was the first country to sign and the second to ratify the Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW). With a strong commitment to women, we welcome the thirtieth anniversary of the Commission created under the adoption of such Convention.
- The Family Code, in force since 1975, is in a process of review and adoption. This
