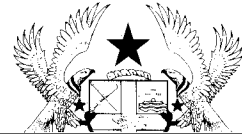

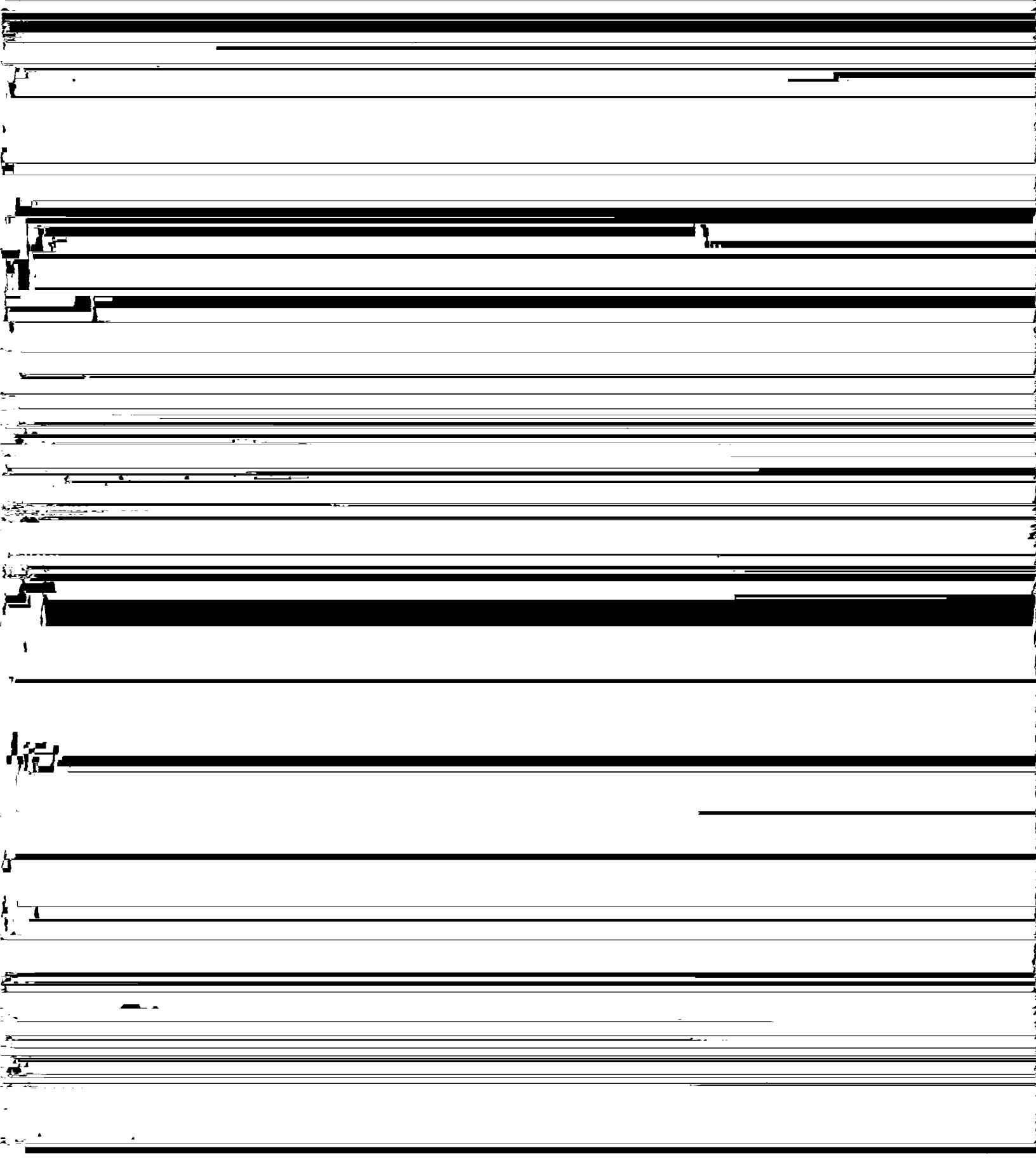
We also bring you felicitations from the new President of Ghana, Dr. Kwame Nkrumah, and
