




Gender equality focus by DAC donor in the sectors of agriculture and rural development

“We will:

- Accelerate and deepen efforts to collect, disseminate, harmonise and make full use of data disaggregated by sex to inform policy decisions and guide investments, **ensuring in turn that public expenditures are targeted appropriately to benefit both women and men.**
- Integrate targets for gender equality and women’s empowerment in **accountability mechanisms**, grounded in international and regional commitments.

Recommendations

- Multilateral institutions, including UN agencies and the multilateral development banks standardise their approach to recording gender equality focussed assistance; publish the data; and report their data to the DAC's Creditor Reporting System.
- The inclusion of gender equality and women's rights dimensions in the future global and local targets and indicators for monitoring the implementation of the Busan Global Partnership for Development Effectiveness.
