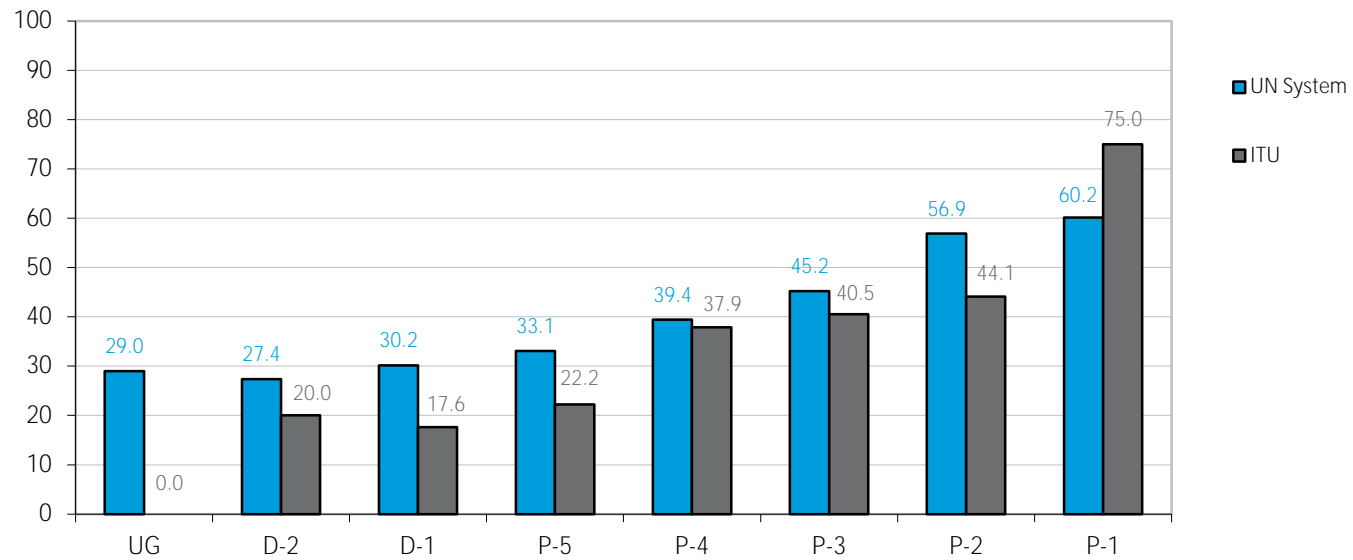


The Status of Women in the United Nations System
